Throughout my career, I have held senior leadership positions in global non-governmental organizations, where I have led large-scale governance programs, spearheaded public-sector reforms, and facilitated collaborative efforts with governments, civil society, and multilateral institutions. My expertise lies in strategic leadership, multi-stakeholder engagement, and policy advocacy, consistently driving transformative changes in national and global governance systems. I am deeply committed to strengthening democratic practices, reducing inequality, and advancing inclusive development for all.

Dr. Hussaini Abdu is a highly regarded public intellectual, international development and humanitarian expert with over 25 years of experience in research, program development, and leadership, spanning more than 47 countries in Africa, Asia, and the Americas. For the past 15 years, he has held the role of Country Director at three major organizations: ActionAid (2009–2015), Plan International (2015–2021), and currently, CARE International since 2021. He serves on the boards of numerous African civil society and research institutions and is the Board Chair of YIAGA Africa, a leading democracy and governance organization, as well as the Chair of Partners West Africa, an organization focused on the rule of law and citizens' security in the region.

From 2006 to 2009, Dr. Abdu was the Head of ActionAid International's Democracy and Governance Programme in Africa, where he coordinated and supported governance and development programs across 23 African countries.
